



Early Years Tadpole Classes



The topic for this half term is **Sun, Sand and Sea Creatures**.



To start this topic we will begin by talking about holidays that we have been on. We will consider places that we have visited, how we travelled there and the fun that we had at the seaside. We will be using maps to look at where the seaside is and consider how seaside habitats vary from Broughton Astley.

We will also be considering animals that live in the sea. We will talk about animals that can be found around the coast of the UK, in particular in rock pools, and comparing those to animals that might be found in tropical seas and colder oceans.



As part of our history we will be comparing holidays that we have today to holidays that people would have been on over 100 years ago. We will learn about the clothes that they wore, entertainment such as Punch and Judy and how that compares to seaside fun today.

At the end of our topic we will be learning about pirates. We will be sharing pirate stories, creating our own pirate maps and dressing up and role playing pirate games.
