As a school we pride ourselves on our diverse curriculum and focus on the arts and sporting activities. Our children get to experience a wide variety of activities across all the arts.

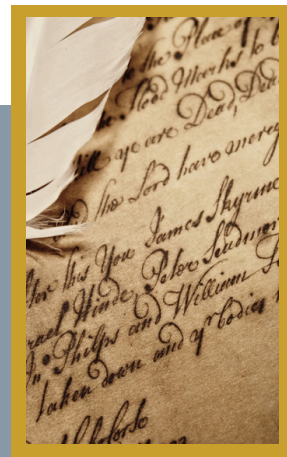
